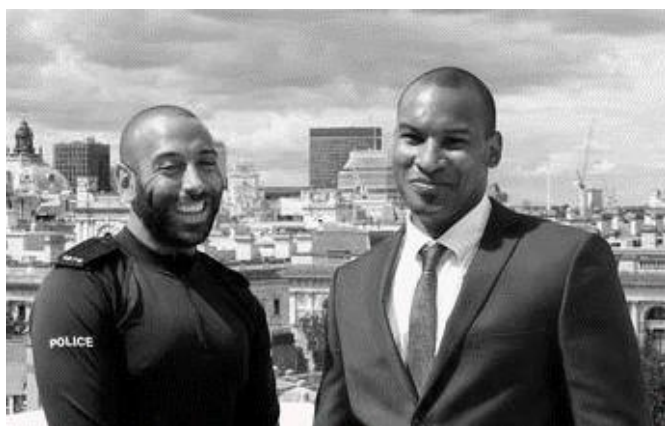

PC Wayne Marques, British Transport Police, for confronting armed terrorists to protect others at London Bridge

On 3rd June 2017, three terrorists carried out a sustained attack on members of the public at London bridge resulting in 8 people being killed and 48 injuries
